WHEREAS, Marigene Valiquette has improved the State of Ohio through her indelible contributions to the public, and she left a lasting impression as a dependable voice for Ohioans. A trailblazing force not only for her generation but also for many to come, she accomplished more in her professional endeavors and her leadership in the Ohio General Assembly, which lasted from 1962 through 1986, than most people do in a lifetime. The six years she spent in the Ohio House of Representatives and the eighteen years serving in the Ohio Senate made her the longest-serving woman in our state's legislature,

and she achieved a great deal while maintaining her abounding 13
