WHEREAS, Unsecured solid waste emitted from trains causes 14 pollution and other threats to public health and safety in 15 communities throughout Ohio, which is of considerable concern in 16 light of the events that unfolded on February 3, 2023, in East 17 Palestine, Ohio; and 18

WHEREAS, Costs to cleanup solid waste along and in the 19 vicinity of rail lines are borne by local governments and 20 individual property owners in Ohio; and 21
