A RESOLUTION

In memory of Dan Ramos. 1

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 135th General Assembly 2
of Ohio were deeply saddened to learn of the death of Dan Ramos and 3
extend our heartfelt condolences to his family and friends; and 4

WHEREAS, Dan Ramos left an indelible impression on the people 5
whose lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a spirited 6
individual who contributed immeasurably to the world around him. Among 7
his endeavors, he served as a policy analyst for former Speaker Armond 8
Budish and Minority Leader Joyce Beatty before being elected to the 9
first of four terms as a member of the Ohio House of Representatives 10
in 2010, and he became the first person of Latino descent to hold a 11
leadership post when he was selected as deputy whip by his peers in 12
2013; and 13

WHEREAS, Dan Ramos' regard for improving the quality of life in 14
our society was clearly evident in his personal sacrifices of time and 15
effort to his family, friends, and community. Giving generously of his 16
energy and abilities in all of his endeavors, he displayed exceptional 17
concern and insight, and his absence will be keenly felt; and 18

WHEREAS, In numerous roles, Dan Ramos always used his talents to 19
the benefit of others, and the laurels of his life stand as a tribute 20
not only to him but also to those he left behind. Although the void 21
his death has created can never be filled, the legacy of care and 22
commitment he established will surely live on. The world is a richer 23
place for his having been in it, and he will be sorely missed; 24
