BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3901.96 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 3901.96. (A) As used in this section:	6
(1) "Nonprofit agricultural membership organization" means	7
an organization or an affiliate of an organization that meets	8
both of the following:	
(a) The organization was incorporated in this state on or	10
before December 31, 1919, for the purpose of promoting the	11
interests of farmers in this state.	12
(b) The organization provides healthcare benefit coverage	13
exclusively to members of the organization and the members'	14
families pursuant to contracts between the members and the	15

organization or its affiliate.	
(2) "Material marketing" means the official written	17
materials and verbal communications provided to, or directed at,	18
prospective members and members' families for advertising or	
<pre>marketing purposes.</pre>	20
(B) Healthcare benefit coverage provided by a nonprofit	21
agricultural membership organization that meets all of the	22
following is not subject to Title XXXIX or Chapter 1739., 1751.,	23
or 1753. of the Revised Code and shall not be considered	24
<pre>insurance under any law of this state:</pre>	25
(1) The healthcare benefit coverage is provided by a	26
nonprofit agricultural membership organization to the	27
<pre>organization's members;</pre>	28
(2) The application for healthcare benefit coverage and	29
any contract provided to a member is in writing;	30
(3) The application for healthcare benefit coverage and	31
any contract provided to a member prominently states both of the	32
<pre>following:</pre>	33
(a) The healthcare benefit coverage is not insurance;	34
(b) The healthcare benefit coverage is not subject to the	35
laws and rules of this state governing insurance.	36
(C) A nonprofit agricultural membership organization shall	37
not represent that healthcare benefit coverage provided by the	38
organization is insurance in any material marketing.	39
(D) The risks arising out of healthcare benefit coverage	40
provided by a nonprofit agricultural membership organization may	41
be assumed or reinsured by a company authorized to conduct the	42
business of insurance in this state.
